PUBLIC NOTICE

This is to bring kind notice of all concerned that Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEF & CC) has notified the Environment Protection (End of Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025 vide S.O. 98 (E) dated 06th January, 2025 and made effective from 1st April 2025. The Rule can be downloaded from CPCB website (weblink: <https://cpcb.nic.in/rules-10/>) (https://cpcb.nic.in/uploads/ELV/ELV_Rules_2025.pdf). Under the provisions of this Rule, Producers (who manufacture/ assemble/ sell/ import of vehicles), Registered vehicle scrapping facility, Bulk Consumer (having more than 100 vehicles including state transport undertaking) are legally obligated for handling, processing and recycling or refurbishing of End of life vehicles (ELVs) in an environmentally sound manner. Scrapping of End-of-Life vehicles means scrapping of steel from End-of-Life vehicles.

The above entities shall fulfill following responsibilities under these Rules:

- All owner of vehicles must ensure their vehicles are registered and tested for fitness at authorized testing stations, with unusable vehicles sent to Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility.
- All Collection Centres for collection of End-of-Life vehicles should send them to Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility in an environmentally sound manner and keep record of it.
- Automated testing stations shall upload the details of all vehicles declared unfit on the centralised online portal either directly or through linking of the electronic portal set up by the Central Government.
- All Producers, Registered vehicle scrapping facility (RVSF), Bulk Consumer are required to be registered on the centralised online EPR portal for ELV of CPCB available at URL <https://eprelv.cpcb.gov.in/>
- Bulk consumer shall deposit the End-of-Life vehicle at designated Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility within a period of one hundred and eighty (180) days from the date the vehicle becomes the End-of-Life vehicle. Bulk consumer shall obtain registration on the centralised online portal from the State Board and file annual return.
- Producers shall fulfil the obligation of Extended Producer Responsibility only through registered entities for the vehicles that the producer has introduced or introduces in the domestic market, including vehicles put to self-use to ensure the scrapping targets.
- Producers shall file Annual Returns and take necessary measures such as buy back scheme, deposit refund scheme or any other, conduct awareness program to encourage the deposition of End-of-Life vehicles at the Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility or designated Collection Centres;
- Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facilities (RVSFs) must undertake activities relating to scrapping of End-of-Life vehicles (such as treatment (de-pollution, collection of liquids, gases, catalyst, mercury containing parts, batteries and hazardous waste), dismantling, segregation, storage, recycling or refurbishing in an environmentally sound manner.
- RVSF shall ensure that all recovered and segregated materials are sent to registered Recyclers or Refurbishers, Co-processors for recycling and reuse. All non-recyclable or non-refurbishable materials and non-utilizable hazardous materials shall be disposed through authorised Common Hazardous Waste Treatment, Storage and Disposal Facilities (TSDFs) under the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- RVSFs shall exchange the Extended Producer Responsibility certificates based on the quantity of steel recovered from the End-of-Life vehicles on the centralized online portal for issuance of Extended Producer Responsibility certificates by Central Board for purchase by the producers; Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility shall file quarterly returns on the centralised online portal to State Board.

- As per the rule 15 of the said rule if any producer, Registered Vehicle Scrapping Facility and bulk consumer fails to comply with the provisions relating to handling and scrapping of End-of-Life vehicles in environmentally sound manner, resulting in environmental damage or risk to public health, shall be liable to pay environmental compensation (EC) as specified by CPCB.

This notice is being issued to inform all Producers, Registered Vehicle scrapping facility, Bulk Consumer if any, operating in the State of Odisha shall register themselves under the online EPR portal of Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi developed under the Environment Protection (End of Life Vehicles) Rules, 2025, within 3 months with a hard copy submission to the State Pollution Control Board, Odisha. They shall comply the different provisions framed under the Rules, failing which action as deemed appropriate including imposition of Environmental Compensation shall be initiated against the defaulter entities under the Environment Protection Act, 1986.
